Venue: Turn from the main road between Toronto and Morisset toward Eraring Power Station. But head EAST (heading toward the lake) at the T junction with Rocky Point Rd. Use the parking area beside the outlet canal. For first arrivals, please only park on the southern side of the car park as Green and Orange courses cross the car park on the way to their first control. We also need to leave some parking space for the general public. Later arrivals should park in Rocky Point Road (along the north side of the road) being careful not to block driveways or access roads.

The assembly area is across the footbridge in the picnic area.

Note: *The event is mostly held on Eraring Power Station land, so consideration of parking directions is vital to continued permission to use the area.*

A nice local area to get the feel for running rather than riding in the bush after months of running the streets and parks. Peter also can't send us up impossible hills this year, as the hills of Eraring are only just high enough to provide the topographical relief needed to make for interesting route choices to clear, distinct features.

2010 NEWCASTLE ORIENTEER OF THE YEAR EVENT 1

Venue: **From the F3** (*Toronto exit*) go toward Toronto (*Palmers Rd*). Turn left into *Wakefield Dr* and head north. About 3 km past Wakefield and before reaching Barnsley, turn left into The Broadway. In Killingworth, turn right into The Boulevard (headed toward West Wallsend). At 500 m look for O-signs.

From Glendale: Travel west through Edgeworth to the big roundabout where you turn south toward Barnsley. At the Barnsley roundabout turn left, then after 1 km turn right into The Boulevard and proceed as above.

Special Note: Two completely different sets of courses are being prepared for NOY1, but only one set will be used. *Hopefully the other will get a run later in the year!* Courses set in the **Burke's Creek/Canyons** area will be used if the dirt track in is considered negotiable by average 2WD vehicles (ie dry weather and potholes not too bad).

If wet, parking will be along Killingworth Rd and we will use **The Range** map.

Moving from Street/Park Events to Bush Orienteering?

You will find that there is a much bigger variety of courses available. Not only do you have to consider the distance and the amount of climbing involved in the course - the most important aspect is the *Navigational Difficulty*. To simplify matters, this aspect is colour coded:

BLUE COURSES

Follow "handrails" - tracks, fences, powerlines, clearings, creeks.

Very easy navigation which includes controls where you have to change direction. Usually 1.6 - 1.9 km

Winning time 16-22 min

GREEN COURSES

Controls are located just off handrails (eg. a boulder 10 m off a track). Easy navigation, but not usually a control at a direction change. Some route choice (use the handrail or cut across).

Usually 2.0 - 3.0 km

Winning time 25-35 min

ORANGE COURSES

Cross country navigation to big features. Route choice. For those taking the direct cross-country option there is a 'catching feature' beyond the control.

At *NOY events*, at Easy Orange course is 2.2 - 2.8 km, with a (harder and) Longer Orange 3 - 4 km

Winning Times: Easy 35-45 min

Long 40-65 min

RED COURSES

Difficult cross-country navigation to small point features. No handrails.

No catching features. Lots of route choice. At *NOY events* there is a Short Red (2.8 - 4 km), Medium Red (4.3-5.3 km) and Long Red (6-7.2 km)

Winning Times: Short 30-50 min

Medium 45-60 min

Long 50-60 min

The actual course distances used at each event are always displayed in the assembly area - but bear in mind those distances are applicable only if you go in straight lines on all legs of the course.

On harder courses, route choices are often made which involve a slightly longer run to offset the navigational difficulty.

A MINOR/TRAINING EVENT: IMPROVE YOUR SKILLS

Venue: From Minmi road, between Edgeworth and the Link Road, turn into Northlakes Drive. Follow this to turn right at the roundabout into Constitution Drive. Follow Constitution Drive to its end and park in the newly developed streets without blocking any construction access.

Map: *Cocked Hat Creek* 1:10 000

The area of bushland that remains here is only small but is still very useful for developing your navigational skills.

Courses: Blue 1.8-2.0km, Green 2-2.5km, Easy Orange 2-2.5km, Long Orange 3-3.5km, Short Red 3-3.5km, Long Red 4.5-5.5km. Distances are only approximate only.

Map: *The Range* 1:10 000

This is the first Coaching Day, developed for orienteers taking the step from Green to Orange standard. Because courses will be set through terrain, long pants are recommended.

There will also be activities for Blue and Green standard.

The activities will follow a briefing at 10:00 am

People wishing to attend need to contact Geoff Todkill (☎ 49585920) by Tuesday 18th May so that maps can be prepared. **Cost:** \$3.00, to cover map printing.

Directions: From Barnsley, turn left into Wakefield Road. After 800m, turn right to Killingworth and follow *The Broadway* for 2.3km. Turn right onto *The Boulevard* (O Signs begin) and follow towards West Wallsend for 1 km. Parking will be along the bitumen road in front of the substation. Follow signs along a narrow track for approx. 100m to the assembly area.

OR - From West Wallsend follow Carrington Street and Railway Street to the Sugar Valley Golf Course, (O Signs begin) and continue on following gravel road towards Killingworth for approx 2 km to the parking and then proceed as above.

What's in the name of a map?

One of the added bonuses to fieldworking and making an orienteering map is to give it a name. Often there is a prominent geographic feature which defines the area - eg Mount Sugarloaf, Whiteheads Lagoon or Cocked-Hat Creek etc. Other names are not so clear.

The Range was so named because it includes the old West Wallsend rifle range.

The **Whitehead** family were early settlers of Myuna Bay with a market garden at the site of the current Sport and Recreation camp.

Whilst working on a new flattish, unspectacular area east of Pelaw Main the mapper felt that the name should convey something about the nature of the terrain to the competitor. Some of the ideas that came to mind were -

(I) "**Meat-ant millions**" or "Meat-ant madness". This would attest to the many meat-ant nests that had to be plotted. Possibly the second name might be better as it would reflect the state of mind of the mapper as he came across an additional nest that had to be aligned to the others. Hopefully the end result is 80-90% accurate.

(II) "**Stanford swamps**". The old parish name for the area appears to be Stanford. The flatness of the area and the effects of old mining activity have produced many large (and small) swamps.

These were uncrossable in winter but nearly dry in summer. There will be more blue on this map than appears on your average Newcastle map.

(III) "**Dumpers delight**" This would reflect the actions of those in society who have no respect for the natural environment.

(IV) "**Trail bike haven**" or "Trail bike heaven" You will really need your glasses to discern the detail of the myriad of tracks and paths that have been created by riders of all ages.

The final name "**Stanford scrubs**" was chosen because there are some large areas of unpleasant scrub and other patches of low, slow-run vegetation.

These will present navigational route choices as you look for corridors of runnable country.

These passages might be in the form of the trail bike / 4WD tracks, or very old indistinct mining tracks.

Many of these very old tracks have been mapped as dry ditches, which might then become watercourses or erosion gullies.

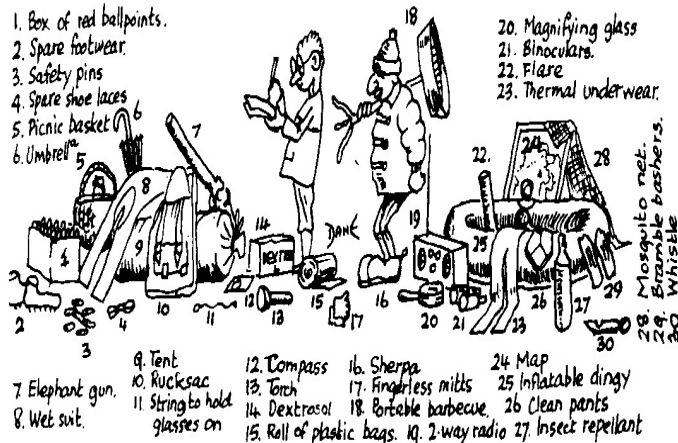
Wayfarers

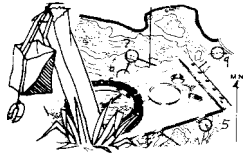
TimeLine

The first OIN Newsletter was in May 1974, months before NOC was formed. OIN2 floated the idea of forming a club, and announced NOC's first contest (Clarencetown, August 74). At that event memberships were taken for the yet to be formed club (\$1 for local juniors up to \$5 for families including affiliation with OANSW - *is that why they talk of the 'good old days'?*).

The club was formed in September 74 and keeps growing - evidenced by membership, events (number and type), participation in the organisation of events, event entries, and success in state and even international events.

In the early years the newsletter was mostly prepared on old gestetner stencils with occasional spirit stencil pages. In the 80s this moved to mostly typed pages being offset printed. Computer use started with OIN89 in 1986 with most pages coming from an Apple 2 via a dot matrix printer. Print quality improved as from OIN176 with MSdos computers and bubble jet and then laser printing. All that remains of the old format is the scanned use of the 'Orienteering in Newcastle' masthead on the first page.

The future? After 36 years and 210 editions, *Allan Wright* is retiring from the editor's chair. With the AGM imminent (11 March) it is time for someone else to take over and decide the future directions.... Hopefully involving some rationalisation between what appears on-line and what needs to be printed - but with the club still initiating communication with its members (and the many non-members we welcome to our events and essentially look on as potential members).



Coaching Page. No 37

Coaching Day 1 (*Green to Orange*) Saturday 22 May
Venue: Killingworth

The first of the coaching days is for orienteers taking the step from Green to Orange standard.

There will also be activities for Blue and Green standard.

The activities will follow a briefing at 10:00 am

Coaching Day 2 (*Orange and Red*) Saturday 31 July
Venue: O'Donnelltown

The second day is for orienteers at Orange and Red level, who would like to develop their skills. The practice activities will be set in short loops to maximise feedback.

There will be no easier courses set.

The activities will follow briefing at 10:00 am.

The newsletter coaching will focus more on Orange and Red levels.

RISK NOTICE

In entering an orienteering event, competitors recognise that the activity has certain inherent risks due to its conduct in the urban and natural environments.

Included in these risks are injury due to rough terrain and obstacles and the effects of heat, cold and exhaustion.

Competitors are also aware that there is no personal accident insurance on their participation in the sport and that they take part at their own risk.

WHISTLES

All orienteers are encouraged to carry a whistle when competing in bush events:

1. To use should they become disabled on the course.
2. As a reminder of the need to offer help upon hearing a whistle distress call

THE DISTRESS CALL IS THREE SHORT WHISTLE BLASTS REPEATED AT REGULAR INTERVALS.

A disabling injury necessitating whistle use would be something like being impaled on a stick, dislocated knee, having a heart attack.

Competitors hearing the distress call should forget their next control and seek out the injured person. Upon locating the person in distress, continue to use a whistle to summon other competitors to help. Someone should stay with the injured person whilst another immediately reports to the finish desk to seek whatever emergency assistance is required.

It is rare for a competitor to become immobilised on a course, but it has happened. There have also been instances where a competitor has unknowingly run off the map and been unable to return by course closure time. Technically, that should trigger a coordinated search, so having a whistle would assist in the search.

Non-magnetic whistles are in short supply, but Margaret Peel has a supply available for sale at events. Please purchase one for everyone in your family, talk about its correct use, and get used to the idea of wearing one.

Of course, 'correct use' does not involve skylarking. Abuse of the whistle (perhaps causing someone to abandon their course unnecessarily) will almost certainly result in disqualification of the offender.

- * *The OANSW reckons it should be six whistle blasts, but this is too much for a seriously injured person, and is out of step with the three (whistle blasts, shots, cooees, fires,...) used by bushwalkers and rescue organisations world wide.*
Such organisations vary in recommended responses (eg during searches) but the best one to use is probably the simplest (as in the Hobart Walking Club's booklet "Safety in the Bush") -

Distress signal by lost/injured party:

Three signals repeated at regular intervals

Searchers looking for lost party

One signal, irregular intervals

Acknowledgment of distress signal

Searchers give one signal

Recall signal

Two signals, repeated after a minute

(But if mobiles work in the area, use them instead!)
