This orienteering course has been constructed by National Parks for use by visitors to Bluegum Hills Regional Park

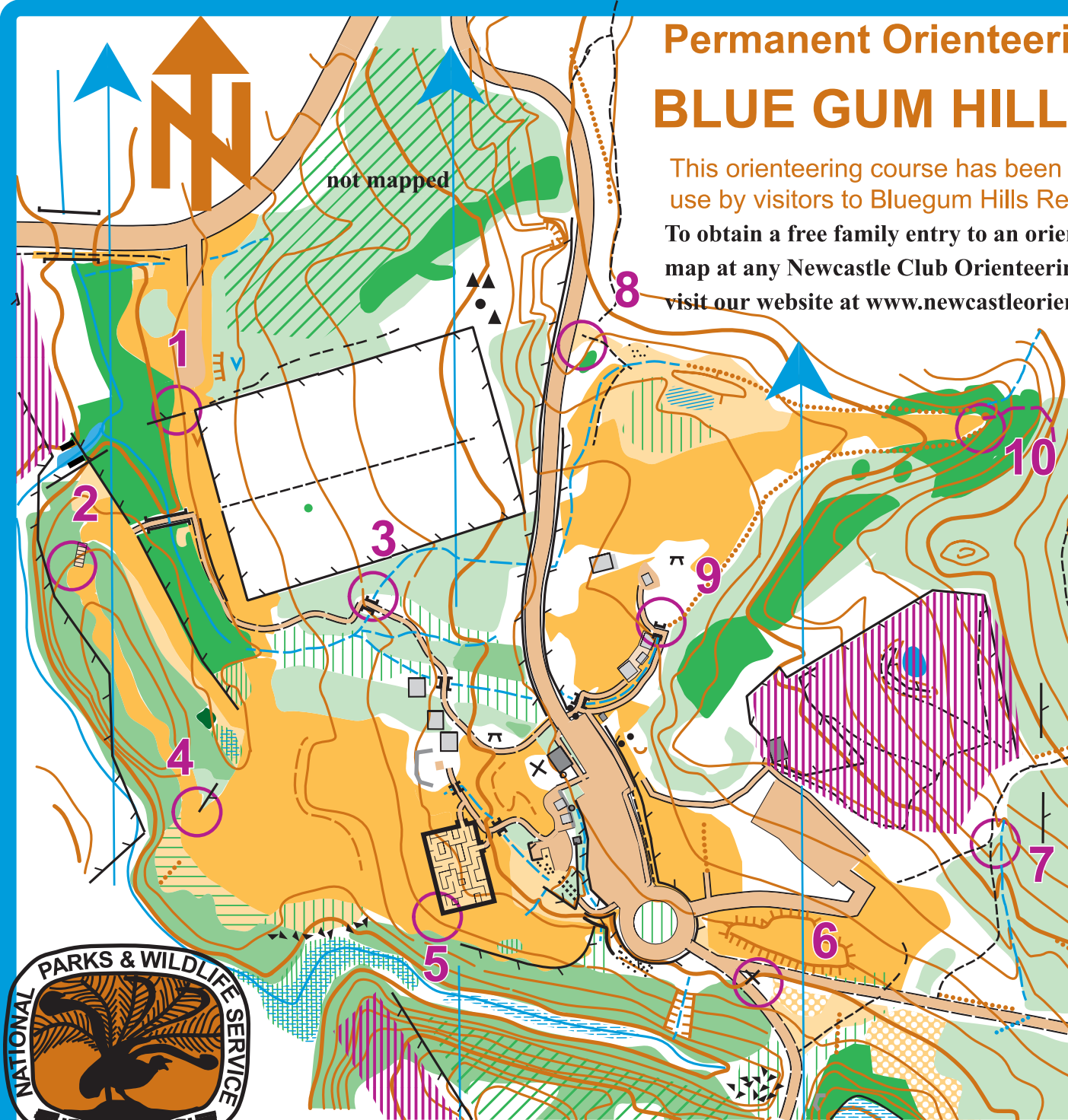
